SPEAKER: Gregory P. Kennedy heads NASTAR University's public outreach efforts to promote science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) education.

Mr. Kennedy is a former Associate Curator for Manned Space Flight at the National Air and Space Museum. At the National Air and Space Museum, he was curator for the Smithsonian's exhibits on aerospace medicine, Project Apollo and rocketry.

Mr. Kennedy has authored, co-authored or edited eight books (with a ninth in progress) and dozens of articles on space history. His particular areas of interest include World II rocket programs, manned stratospheric balloon projects and the early years of the space program in America.
